

LUXBOROUGH PARISH COUNCIL

The minutes of the Extra-Ordinary Meeting of Luxborough Parish Council held on 30 March 2022 at Luxborough Village Hall at 7.30.

Public Question Time: No members of the public were in attendance.

21/74 The Chairman opened the meeting and welcomed those present.

21/75 Apologies for absence. Cllr J Duke.

21/76 Declarations of interest. Cllr Tombleson regarding agenda item 4)b and c) (Holywell planning application).

21/77 Planning a) 6/2/22/101 Hall Farm. The PC considered it unlikely that the plans would affect any neighbours. It noted that the installation of dormer windows was common for barns and their conversions in the parish. The proposals are likely to improve the quality of family accommodation with a motion passed to support the application. b and c) 6/20/22/102 and 6/20/22/103LB Holywell Cottage. Cllrs were pleased to see proposals to replace the existing garage with ancillary accommodation which appeared to be sympathetically designed in keeping with the original building. It was resolved to support the applications. **d) Other Planning matters.** Cllrs queried whether a fresh agricultural building had been erected on the Hall Farm site and the Clerk was asked to raise this with the Planning Enforcement Officer.

21/78 Queen's Platinum Jubilee Mugs. Cllrs resolved to buy a commemorative mug for every child in the parish under S.137 (Local Government Act). At £4.56 per item this will cost approximately £180.
